



How to Connect Wirelessly to the Internet

1. For a wireless connection, an **Ethernet Cable** *does not* need to be connected to your computer / tablet.
2. Check that the antenna/router/gateway of your computer / tablet is enabled by seeing that the LED or wireless light is lit and green.
3. Find your **Wireless Connection** by clicking as follows:



4. Double click on the following wireless network:

5. Because you are on a **Security-enabled Wireless Network**, you will be asked for the network key.
6. The **Wireless Encryption Key** is the Network Key below:

Confirm the **Network Key** which is the same code above. **Please Note: This information is located at the bottom of your internet modem.** The Network Key is case sensitive.



9. Windows will now connect.

If the **Wireless Encryption Key** was entered incorrectly, Windows will ask for it again. If entered correctly, Windows XP will connect to the **Wireless Network**.

10. Once **Connected** to the Wireless Network, you can begin surfing the Internet.
